- 1 That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we looked upon and have touched with our hands, concerning the word of life —

- 3 that which we have seen and heard we proclaim also to You, so that You too may have fellowship with us; and indeed our fellowship is with the Father and with His Son Jesus Christ.**

- 10 If we say we have not sinned, we make Him a liar, and His word is not in us.**

- 1 My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous.**
- 2 He is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the sins of the whole world.**

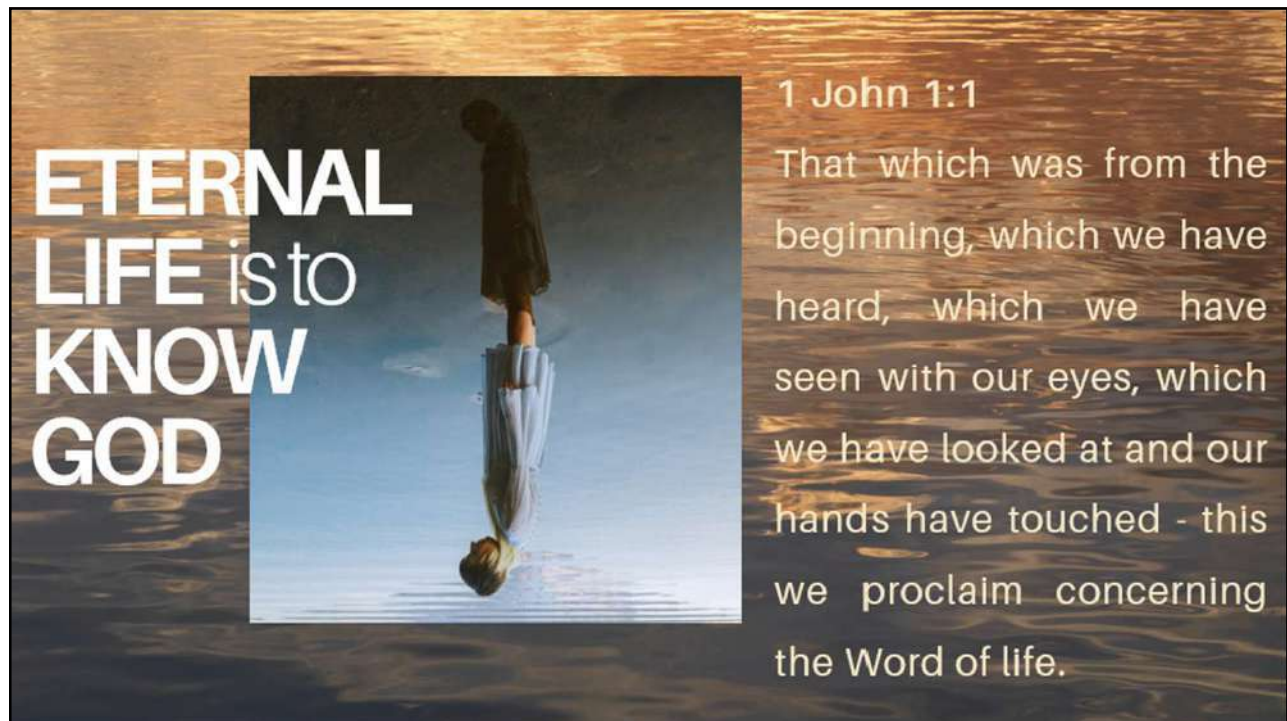

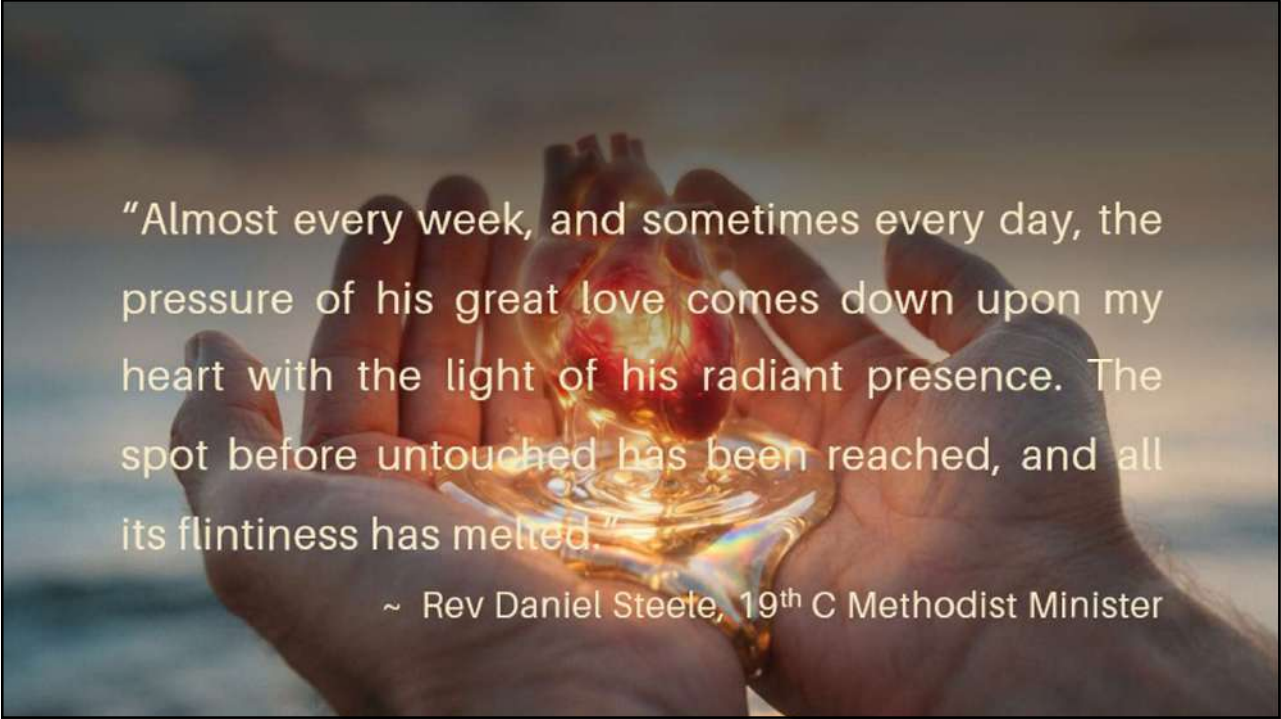

I. THE FOUNDATION OF FELLOWSHIP (1:1-4)

- **An Eternal Reality** - "That which was from the beginning..." (v. 1a).
- **Historical Evidence** - "which we have heard...seen... looked at... touched..." (v. 1b).
- **Divine Revelation** - "the word of Life." (v. 1c).
